MUD HONEY set the pace off the rail, edged clear in early stretch, then maintained her advantage to the wire under urging. SUPERSONIC BEAUTY stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch but couldn't gain on the winner while wearing down WITH MOMS BLESSING for the place. The latter, prompted the pace three wide outside MUD HONEY into the stretch, then weakened. MICHELLE'S TRIP reserved in striking position off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. SOUTHERN MAGGIE failed to menace. BON BON rated off the pace, faltered leaving the far turn.
