APPEALING RUSSIAN angled out for the stretch run, rallied to take over command at the sixteenth pole and was fully extended to prevail. MARINGRI, off slowly, angled very wide for the stretch run and closed willingly. SKIRTS A FLYING bumped at the start, angled wide for the stretch run and rallied for the show. YELLOW BEAUTY forwardly placed along the rail, steadied briefly trying to get through tight quarters in midstretch, then gained some ground. STEPPIN CLEVER vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch and tired. TALULLAH vied for the lead between horses and tired. LOVE LEGENDS vied for the lead three wide and faltered. I'M HOOKED ON HOPE was not a factor. ZIP HER UP checked when she broke in at the start and was outrun. BEAUMISSEY was no threat after stumbling at the start. ROBIN IN SPRING was never close. CLOULETTE bumped with SKIRTS A FLYING and steadied at the start, then showed little.
