MISS ANNIE BEA set the pace off the rail into the stretch, then drew off when set down. RAISED EYEBROWS chased the winner into the stretch but was no match for that rival while proving second best. NOREENA THE GREAT unhurried early, raced off the rail and closed to gain the show. VEGAS ALARM stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then was tiring when her rider lost his whip. SALITROSA was no factor after being outrun early. HAWK CLIFF saved ground to no avail. BAZARGAN rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and faltered. COOK'N LIGHT was through early and eased in the final eighth.
