HALO MOON set the pace along the inside and was under urging to hold sway. MOOCHIE TOO unhurried early, raced four wide on the turn and closed well for the place. CRIMSON COMET chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then didn't do enough late while being edged for the place. ASTORBILT reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and gained some ground without threatening. CRAFTY DIVA outrun early, raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. BON JOUR PARIS was not a factor. UNHURRIED chased the winner into the stretch and faltered. FOURTH DAUGHTER tired from good position. ROSIES WILD LIPS saved ground and faded.
