SIR VINSKY off slowly, chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole and drew away under a hand ride. SAGAMORE vied for the lead inside QUIET HONOREE into the stretch, then was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage to hold the place. CAMBRIAN showed speed along the rail, was steadied from tight quarters soon after entering the turn, recovered and closed to gain the show. GEORGE'S DANCE broke slowly, then was saving ground when checked in behind CAMBRIAN soon after entering the turn, angled out for the drive and tired. GOTTA BIN TO WIN well placed after bumping soundly with RUNNING BUCKEROO at the start, faltered in the drive. QUIET HONOREE vied for the lead outside SAGAMORE into the stretch, then faded. RUNNING BUCKEROO trailed after bumping with GOTTA BIN TO WIN and being steadied at the start.
