TRUE WILL showed speed off the rail, drew clear around the turn, then was fully extended to hold off BABA'S MANDATE. The latter, unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and closed well to be up for the place. HELLO POOCHI POOH chased the pace three wide into the stretch and was gaining on the winner at the finish. HOLLY GO LIVELY tracked the pace into the stretch and closed with a mild response. BOBS PINUP GIRL failed to menace. ROCKIN INTHE RAIN pressed the pace along the rail, steadied soon after entering the turn, continued to chase the winner into the stretch and gave way. WISE NOTE chased the pace four wide around the turn and tired. FANCY STEPPER was done early.
