TIMUCUAN DAWN set the pace racing off the rail and just saved the place while being outfinished. LA CICALÉ chased the pace three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. SISTER GRACIE unhurried while saving ground, angled out in the stretch and closed with a belated rally. BAZARGAN off slowly, was always outrun. MORICA prompted the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. DONA GLADY'S showed early foot, raced along the inside on the turn and faltered. ARDENT LOVER showed little and bled.
