SLAM RUNNER pressed the pace along the inside, dropped back and eased three wide on the far turn, rallied to take over in the stretch, opened a clear lead at the sixteenth pole, then was all out to last over STING CUT. The latter, allowed to settle, began advancing three wide around the far turn, her rider then lost whip in early stretch and a pair of goggles, was able to grab another set of goggles, then used those to apply pressure to his mount and was gaining on the winner at the finish. CRYSTAL GLITTER outrun early, rallied along the inside to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. LADY MAURA'S IMAGE pressed the pace three wide, moved to take over entering the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then tired. PERFIDIA LIGHT set the pace under pressure off the rail to the far turn, then faltered. SHADOW MOON was done early and eased in the stretch run.
