Footnotes

PUMA set the pace along the inside, drew well clear around the turn and remained clear to the wire under pressure. JOKEY unhurried early, saved ground and closed to be up for the place. AMERICAN BULLET outrun early, advanced three wide around the turn, then didn't do enough late. FIRST TOUR chased the pace around the turn and tired. BET THE SIGHTS up close early, faltered. FAST DEPARTURE was done early.
