Footnotes

HOPEFUL IMAGE steadied from close quarters at the start, tracked the pace into the stretch, then rallied outside the leaders to be just up at the wire. PERF bobbled at the start, chased the pace into the stretch, made a run to try SAMANTHA G and edged that rival for the place while unable to hold off the winner at the wire. SAMANTHA G opened a clear lead racing down the backstretch, set the pace along the inside to deep stretch and gave way grudgingly. MARIJA'S WISH checked repeatedly to avoid running up on TRACI LEA around the first turn, was attempting to move through inside that rival when checked again on the backstretch, continued to save ground into the far turn, angled out for the drive and never threatened. TRACI LEA showed early foot along the rail, couldn't stay with the leaders racing down the backstretch and tired in the drive. WILMETTE reserved off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faltered in the drive. CUMANA was no factor after being steadied entering the first turn. TALKIN TIGER up close early, raced three wide around the far turn and faded.
