STREET APPEAL stalked the pace, was steadied in behind MY BEST CHINA leaving the turn, rallied to catch that rival at the eighth pole, then drew clear. MISS LEONARDO reserved racing along the rail, closed to prove second best while unable to stay with the winner. MY BEST CHINA set the pace under pressure racing off the rail, drifted out at the top of the stretch while maintaining her advantage, then gave way in the final eighth. BREEZY G rated in striking position off the pace, tired in the drive. FRESH CALL drifted in at the start, raced three wide around the turn and failed to menace. GALACIA FOREST chased the pace three wide around the turn and faltered. ROCK A TONG was no factor after breaking a step slowly. TAC A CAT pressed the pace along the rail to midway of the turn, then faded.
