RICH MARQUET allowed to settle after breaking slowly, rallied three wide to take over leaving the far turn, then drew clear under urging. SILLY CAT stalked the pace along the rail, was steadied when unable to get through inside STORMY DREW on the far turn, recovered and slipped through along the rail to reach the attending position at the top of the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. GIMMEAMINK unhurried after bumping with NEVERNOTADAY at the start, passed tired rivals without threatening. SYLVIA TWICE pressed the pace outside STORMY DREW, took over from that rival on the far turn, made the pace to the quarter pole, then gave way. MANDATED TO WIN saved ground and tired. STAR BITE rated off the pace, faltered leaving the far turn. SHARP LATIN MINT was through after six furlongs. STORMY DREW set the pace under pressure into the far turn, then faded and was eased in the final eighth. KISSINACOP bumped with NEVERNOTADAY at the start, showed some early foot, stopped and was pulled up in the stretch run. NEVERNOTADAY rank and never close after being bumped between rivals at the start, was pulled up in the stretch run.
