DEFENSE MODE tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch, eased outside STARSHIP SULU for room, then rallied to be just up at the wire. STARSHIP SULU vied for the lead along the rail, drew clear in the stretch, then just failed to last. GASPARRILLA CAPTAIN reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and finished full of run to just miss the place. ULTIMATE CHOICE chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then rallied while being edged to the wire by the top ones. SKIBO IN JULY vied for the lead outside STARSHIP SULU into the stretch, then gave way. KINVARA failed to menace.
