ICANSEECLEARLY made a run along the inside soon after entering the backstretch to reach even terms for command, vied for the lead along the inside, came off the rail for the stretch run and opened a clear advantage, then was fully extended to last over WEEKEND IN DEVON. The latter, stalked the pace along the inside, was steadied in behind ICANSEECLEARLY soon after entering the far turn, remained along the inside and was gaining slowly on that rival at the finish. BRUNSWICK BELLE showed speed off the rail, responded when challenged by ICANSEECLEARLY on the backstretch, was outmoved in early stretch but finished willingly to hold the show. RIDING rated off the pace, made a run three wide on the far turn to loom a threat but had no late response. MARIA'S SUNSHINE was never a factor. WINNIEDAWHALE saved ground to no avail. SILVER TOUCH chased the pace three wide to the far turn and faded.
