Footnotes

SUMMER OF SUMMERS sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the stretch, responded when headed by SOY LATINO and came on again to dead heat with that rival. SOY LATINO chased the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole, then was all out to finish on even terms for the win after his rider lost his whip in the final yards. HARD MOONSHINE hit the gate at the start, tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and had no late response. ISLE REPO IT outrun after being steadied in behind FIRST CARD AN ACE leaving the chute, failed to menace. FIRST CARD AN ACE was steadied when he ducked in at the gap leaving the chute, saved ground around the turn and tired. SERAPI CAT was not a factor. CHALLENGE PRIDE was outrun after breaking awkwardly.
