SPECTACULAR SKY set the pace off the rail into the stretch, then drew clear under urging. CLOSE IT OUT rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch while advancing into contention but couldn't gain on the winner while dead heating with BLACK DIAMOND CAT. The latter, chased the pace off the rail into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while finishing on even terms for the place. AMERICAN LEGEND chased the pace along the rail around the turn and tired. THANK U PHILIPPE reserved off the pace, was steadied to avoid running up on rivals approaching the quarter pole and faltered. ISLAND SUNSET tracked the pace, advanced three wide to loom a threat midway of the turn, then faded.
