Footnotes

THE BEST GLACIER stalked the pace, moved up to engage HUGO LIGHT soon after entering the far turn, vied with that rival, then drifted in front of that one in early stretch and drew clear. HUGO LIGHT set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by THE BEST GLACIER on the far turn, vied for the lead into the stretch, then steadied when that rival crossed in front of him and was outfinished. SOUTHERN GLITTER prompted the pace outside HUGO LIGHT to the far turn, then faltered. MOTIN tracked the pace to nearing the far turn and faded. GROVE HALL was through after a half mile. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF HUGO LIGHT, THE BEST GLACIER WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SECOND FOR INTERFERENCE TO THAT RIVAL IN EARLY STRETCH.
