CADET LOGAN rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole and edged away. WELL DONE SON vied for the lead along the inside to past the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. MY NAME IS JAKE stalked the pace, angled three wide and made a run at the leaders at the quarter pole, then weakened in the drive. MAD PATRIOT outrun early, passed tired rivals without threatening. BACK TO VALUES chased the pace three wide to midway of the turn, then tired. ECLIPTICALSWILDCAT vied for the lead outside WELL DONE SON to past the quarter pole, then faltered. AMERICAN PROUD raced wide down the backstretch and was outrun. MIA'S BULLET broke poorly and was distanced.
