WHOS CRYING NOW bumped with PREDAWN RAID at the start, reserved off the pace, three wide around the far turn, took over at the head of the stretch, drew clear, then was all out to last over LAWBOOK. The latter, unhurried early, raced off the rail on the far turn, angled out for the drive and rallied to just miss. SUPERVISOR trailed into the far turn along the inside, rallied belatedly to gain the show. HAL'S IMAGE vied for the lead between horses into the backstretch, continued to contest the lead outside CURRENT NINER into the stretch and gave way. The latter, vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch and tired. MISTER FOTIS bumped with PREDAWN RAID at the start, raced in good position and was eased in the drive. PREDAWN RAID jostled between horses at the start, showed brief foot and was eased. OBSIDIAN vied for the lead outside HAL'S IMAGE into the backstretch, was through after half and eased.
