### Footnotes

SUGARTIME JAZZ showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then drew clear when asked. MISS MARTIN well placed while saving ground, eased out in the stretch and closed to prove second best. BLUE DISTINCTION chased the pace four wide into the stretch and gave way. WIFE AND KID raced in striking position five wide around the turn, then tired. WHIMSICAL GAL broke awkwardly, then steadied from tight quarters leaving the chute, moved up quickly to race in contention between horses to nearing the top of the stretch and faltered. CUTIE'S ROSIE chased the pace off the rail around the turn, then had nothing left. IMAGE OF LADY ROSE showed early foot three wide and faded. LUCY BUG was outrun.
