Footnotes

TWISTED DREAM stalked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, maintained that advantage to past the eighth pole, then drew clear. STAGE DELI unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. GONE STRAIGHT stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside GENERAL GUTI leaving the far turn to reach near even terms for command, tried the winner to past the eighth pole, then weakened. MANNY WHO stalked the pace four wide, made a run to reach near even terms for command in the stretch, then gave way. GENERAL GUTI set the pace off the rail to nearing the top of the stretch, then tired. UNTUTTTABLE AFFAIR raced three wide and failed to menace. RUN SMART ONE steadied in the early going, raced four wide around the far turn and was not a factor. HIGH BRASS rated off the pace, faltered leaving the far turn. LION THUNDER showed early foot along the inside and faded.
