ISLAND MAIDEN reserved early, rallied three wide to take over at the eighth pole and drew clear under pressure. MANUMIT unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. SMILIN VIGGIE reserved early, raced four wide around the turn and closed to gain the show. SIBERGACE outrun early, raced wide and passed tired rivals. DON'T HANG UP KRIH failed to menace. BUCKY'S LINE was never a factor. KETSHUP chased the pace, made a run at the leader at the quarter pole, then tired. WOW HE'S NICE angled over to make the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way in the final eighth. CHICAGO'S PARTY chased the leaders around the turn and faltered. SECRET POCKETS steadied in tight quarters on the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn and faded. SIBERIAN SURPRISE showed speed to the turn and stopped. THIS MUST BE LOVE was through early.
