HAWK CLIFF rated along the rail, was forced to wait for room leaving the far turn, slipped through and rallied to gain the lead just inside the eighth pole, then edged away. LOVE ONE ANOTHER reserved early, rallied four wide around the far turn to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while clearly second best. BRUNSWICK BELLE set the pace along the inside, came off the rail at the top of the stretch and gave way. REALLY STRIKING tracked the pace three wide into the far turn, then tired. TECHNICAL QUESTION saved ground to no avail. SWEETEST DREAM was outrun while racing four wide. CROWNING MYSTERY prompted the pace outside BRUNSWICK BELLE, made a run to reach even terms for command on the far turn, then faltered. BAZARGAN dwelt at the start and failed to threaten.
