HES IN MY POCKET bumped with I'VE REPENTED and steadied at the start, raced three wide around the turn, rallied to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole and drew clear. I'VE REPENTED rated off the pace after bumping with HES IN MY POCKET at the start, was rallying into contention when steadied in behind the leaders at the top of the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while proving second best. FIUMES set the pace under pressure along the inside into the the stretch and tired. GREAT VICTORIAN pressed the pace outside FIUMES into the stretch, then faltered. MOREAPPLAUSEPLEASE raced along the rail and never threatened. COMPRISE trailed after being checked when ducked in at the gap leaving the chute.
