GOOD MORNIN JORDAN set the pace racing off the rail, responded when challenged by COMPRISE on the far turn, then dueled with that rival to the wire and prevailed. COMPRISE stalked the pace, made a run three wide to reach GOOD MORNIN JORDAN on the far turn, then dueled with that rival and was outgamed to the wire. KADARKA tracked the pace along the inside, then couldn't keep pace with the winners while gaining the show. CASH N CARRY failed to menace while racing four wide. PENDER'S TUNE reserved off the pace, made a run three wide to reach contention on the far turn, then gave way. DISTINCT COLONY raced in contention four wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. EJECTION FRACTION chased the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then faltered. TANGO RIDGE raced five wide and faded. GREAT BLADE chased the pace for a half mile, then had nothing left.
