TOP BUSINESS stalked the pace along the rail, rallied and slipped through inside STAMEN at the top of the stretch to gain the lead, then drew clear under urging. BAD NEWS CAPTAIN rated off the pace, angled out at the top of the stretch and closed with a mild rally to be up for the place. MASCALO chased the pace off the rail into the stretch, weakened and finished on even terms with RED ZONE FLYER. The latter, reserved early, saved ground while advancing into the stretch and closed to dead heat for the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. STAMEN showed speed along the inside, came out a bit at the top of the stretch and tired. TORMENTO chased the pace three wide around the turn, then faltered.
