DECAPOLIS stalked the pace, drew even on the far turn, was brushed and outmoved by BET HIGH in the stretch, then came again and edged that rival. BET HIGH unhurried early, rallied three wide, lugged in briefly brushing with DECAPOLIS while taking over command in early stretch but couldn't hold off the winner late. YANKS LEGEND reserved off the pace, passed tired rivals. JELLY FISH, off slowly, stalked the pace, gained a brief lead on the far turn, then tired. THIRD ROCKETTE set the pace along the inside and stopped. CORUNDUM CERA was through early. NATIONAL GLORY (VEN) showed nothing. The rider of BET HIGH lodged an objection against the rider of DECAPOLIS for alleged interference in early stretch. The claim of foul was not allowed.
