Footnotes

FORMAL MISS up close while saving ground, eased outside DAKOTA LIGHT in the stretch, rallied to catch that rival just inside eighth pole and drew off under a strong hand ride. DAKOTA LIGHT vied for the lead along the hedge into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while continuing on with good courage to save the place. MISS TASSY reserved early, advanced into contention three wide on the far turn, swung out for the drive and closed to be up for the show. SPECTACULAR LISA rated off the pace, made a run three wide on the far turn to join the leaders racing into the stretch, then tired. RUNNING DEBATE outrun early, advanced off the hedge to reach contention in the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. DYNA FLYER unhurried early, improved her position in the drive without threatening. KING'S FANCY advanced on the first turn to reach the leaders, vied for the lead outside DAKOTA LIGHT, then tired in the drive. SWEETTRICKYDANCER steadied in tight quarters on the first turn and failed to menace. SPLASHA raced

three wide on the far turn and was not a factor. P. J.'S ESKIMO chased the leaders into the far turn and faltered. STARSHIP DAYDREAM showed little. SMART JULIET saved ground into the far turn and faded.
