SOTHATSWHEREWEREAT vied for the lead outside SWEETTOUHERNTIMES, then couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while continuing on with good courage for the place. SWEETSOUTHERNTIMES vied for the lead along inside and tired. DUCHESS D'OR chased the pace along the inside around the turn and faltered. FRIEND'S CASE was not a factor. CANAGUA up close early, faded. LEGAL TESTAMONY trailed.
