Footnotes

NIC'S AMIGO unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn and rallied to be up late. FABU IN chased the pace, rallied to take over on the turn and opened a clear lead but couldn't hold off the winner late. COMMANDER BAY chased the pace three wide around the turn and closed to just miss the place while being outfinished by the winner. PROFICIENT ONE outrun early, improved his position without threatening. KING MONGO showed speed off the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. THOMASTOWN saved ground and faltered. MYSTIC CHARGER rated in striking position off the pace, faded. JUMP CUT was no factor after stumbling at the start. DOCTOR DUKE showed brief speed, stopped and was eased in the final eighth.
