**Footnotes**

FOR THE WIN stalked the pace along the rail, was blocked and checked in behind IT'S A D'WILDCAT on the far turn, came around that rival entering the stretch, rallied to gain the lead in early stretch, then was under hand ride to prevail. STARSHIP PLEASANT stalked the pace, angled out in the stretch and finished willingly to prove best of the rest. SWEET IRISH ROSE rated off the pace, rallied three wide to gain the lead approaching the quarter pole, made the pace into the stretch, then tired. HIGHLAND SARA stalked the pace off the rail, made a run to gain a brief lead on the far turn, then faltered. IT'S A D'WILDCAT set the pace along the inside into the far turn, then was fading when steadied leaving that turn.
