ALEXANDRA VICTORIA contested the pace while off the rail, shook free from MISS ABERDEEN while still in hand approaching the stretch then increased her advantage when roused for the drive. RUNNINGWITHHONORS never far back, raced a bit wide into the stretch and was second best while no threat to the winner. MISTY FROLIC passed tired ones. B. A. MARINE passed tired. MISS ABERDEEN slipped inside the leaders to gain a short advantage into the far turn, could not match strides with the winner after five-eighths and had little left through the stretch. LETSRINGTHEBELL weakened. GRADUATION PARTY was outrun and eased to the wire. BUCK AND WING raced far back and was eased to the wire. PREMIENNE contested the pace while kept off the rail, steadied sharply from between horses approaching the turn, dropped back suddenly and was eased to the wire.
