Footnotes

DREAMING OF LES stalked the pace three wide, moved to gain command on the far turn, then drew away under urging. HOLD THAT CAMERA unhurried early, advanced into contention around the far turn but couldn't get to the winner while clearly best of the rest. LIV N' RUN reserved racing along the inside into the far turn, angled out and passed tired rivals for the show. I'VE GOT THE BLING pressed the pace outside GO ZAPPER into the far turn, then couldn't stay with the winner and gave way in the drive. GO ZAPPER set the pace under pressure along the rail to midway of the far turn, then tired. WHYTIGER well placed while saving ground, faltered on the far turn. FRANKLINPARK raced four wide and never threatened. KNOWA was not a factor. EDGE AHEAD rated off the pace, faded leaving the far turn. FAST BREAK was through after a half mile.
