CONCERTOS SONG set the pace along the inside into the stretch, then drew off when roused. KID CAROUSEL chased the winner off the rail into the stretch but was no match for that rival while proving best of the others. AFLEET MAGIC reserved off the pace after being steadied from tight quarters on the first turn, raced three wide around the far turn and closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. CALIFORNIA STRIKE tracked the leaders off the rail into the far turn and tired. CRACKLIN saved ground to no avail. WINAWAY steadied at the start, then was no factor while saving ground. CATCH RIKKI failed to menace. FREDDY THE CAP stalked the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then faltered. BRAVE APACHE broke in the air, stalked the pace for a half mile and faded.
