CASINO GAMBLER reserved racing along the rail, rallied inside IM GOOD AT THAT to take over just past the eighth pole, then drew clear under urging. KIDSTRONG FEVER chased the pace four wide into the stretch and wore down IM GOOD AT THAT for the place while unable to match strides with the winner. IM GOOD AT THAT bumped with CANDI'S HALO at the start, showed speed off the rail to the eighth pole, then gave way. ANOTHER SUCCESS tracked the leaders five wide around the turn and tired. FURIOUS RUN failed to menace. COCO TOP was not a factor. CANDI'S HALO bumped with IM GOOD AT THAT at the start, chased that rival three wide into the stretch, then faltered. DOC GREEN off slowly, was outrun. SCRUPLES IN raced five wide and faded.
