RIO GREY prompted the pace outside RITMO CRIOLLO, moved up to engage that rival on the far turn, vied for the lead to nearing the sixteenth pole, then edged away while drifting out. UNO AGAIN rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat but couldn't get to the winner while gaining the place. RITMO CRIOLLO set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by RIO GREY on the far turn, then vied with that rival to nearing the sixteenth pole and gave way. SWEETSOUTHERNMAN failed to menace. BE MY FRANKENSTEIN reserved early, moved into contention three wide on the far turn, then tired in the drive. SARAVA STAR stalked the pace, angled four wide for room on the far turn and faltered. EURO TIGER stalked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then faded.
