WILD MARTHA stalked the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to hold CREME 'D LITE safe. The latter, rated off the pace, angled outside the leaders in the stretch and was gaining on the winner at the finish. DOUGH GIRL tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. PRINCESS ALERT allowed to settle, raced three wide on the far turn and had no late response. SALITROSA was no factor after being outrun early. MISS PTARMIGAN saved ground and lacked a rally. LOST FACT sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the far turn and faded.
