GATOR'S TRACKS outran rivals to gain the lead racing into the first turn, made the pace along the inside, drew clear leaving the far turn and into the stretch, then was all out to last over RED ORCHESTRA. The latter, rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied to just miss catching the winner. A LITTLE OFF stalked the pace, dropped back racing around the far turn, angled out for the stretch run and came on again for the show. APPELLA'S WONDER stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. SUPERSONIC BEAUTY stalked the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch, then gave way. BALA ROJA allowed to settle, raced four wide around the far turn and failed to menace. LIME TIME outran early, saved ground and never threatened. SHEHASHIGHOPES well placed early, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. STARSHIP STREAKER steadied along the inside in the early going and was not a factor. MISS MUFFIN turned in a dull effort.
