GREAT BEAR stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner while clearly best of the rest. ALISA'S ENGINEER stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. TOTAL REWARD failed to menace. STORMY JACKSON reserved off the pace, faltered in the drive. EL COBRE stalked the pace into the far turn, then was fading when steadied at the top of the stretch and continued to drop back.
