CRIMSON SOCKS rated off the pace, rallied three wide to take over on the far turn, then dueled with RARE TREASURE through the stretch and prevailed. RARE TREASURE reserved early, rallied on the far turn to reach even terms for command inside CRIMSON SOCKS entering the stretch, then was just edged to the wire after a stretch long duel. ROMACA reserved off pace, saved ground into the stretch, angled out and closed to prove best of the rest. RUSLANOVA rated in striking position off the pace, couldn't keep pace with the top ones in the drive. SUPAH JACKIE vied for the lead outside JACK'S TOUCH into the far turn and tired. R RAGGEDY ANN unhurried early, made a run three wide on the far turn to reach contention, then faltered. MANTUA was not a factor. JACK'S TOUCH vied for the lead along the rail to the far turn and faded. STACK FIRST was outrun after being checked when she swerved out at the start. MUSICAL PIROUETTE chased the pace three wide to nearing the far turn and stopped.
