SKIPTOIT prompted the pace outside SARAFRAS, took over from that rival nearing the eighth pole, then drew off under urging. SARAFRAS showed speed along the inside into the stretch but was no match for the winner while holding the place. FULL N SASSY reserved after being steadied along the rail on the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, eased out and closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. LUCKY DEUCE raced in striking position into the stretch, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while being edged for the show. PRIZE FEVER tracked the pace into the stretch, then tired. EMMA'S KNIGHT tracked the leaders four wide around the turn and faltered. GRAY FLASH tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then faded. BWANA EXPRESS trailed.
