Closed Saturday, September 3, 2011 with 17 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth).

Footnotes

MANICERO rated off the pace, advanced into contention around the far turn, eased out and rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole, then was all out to hold off STAR OF SARAVA. The latter, allowed to settle, swung out for room approaching the stretch, then responded to pressure and was gaining on the winner at the finish. OLIGARCH set the pace along the inside, edged away leaving the far turn but couldn't match strides with the top ones in the final sixteenth. SILVER CLOUD pressed the pace outside OLIGARCH to nearing the stretch, then gave way. TOO EXPERIENCE unhurried after breaking slowly, angled out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. THE WACO KID reserved early, moved up four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. THE BEST GLACIER outrun early, failed to threaten. CACTUS KID was not a factor. GREAT SCOT was through after a half mile. LAKE NONA showed early foot, tracked the leaders into the far turn and faltered. RIBO BOBO hit the gate at the start, stalked the pace three wide into the far turn, then faded.
