SOUTHAFRICAN QUEEN stalked the pace, made a run three wide to reach the leaders on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. VALID DISTINCTION set the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then tired. JAZZY MOVES raced four wide and failed to menace. SWEET LIL CHEROKEE steadied twice in behind MISS MARY FINN in the early going and was not a factor. MISS MARY FINN checked and rank in the early going, faded on the far turn. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENTS IN THE EARLY GOING. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
