Footnotes

CALLMETHESQUEEZE unhurried early, angled out four wide on the far turn, rallied to catch BLUE ANGEL EXPRESS inside the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. BLUE ANGEL EXPRESS reserved racing along the inside, eased out leaving the far turn, rallied to gain a brief lead at the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. PRIZE INFORMANT quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside to nearing the eighth pole, then weakened. EL BENDINAT rated in striking position off the pace, saved ground into the stretch and had no response when asked. BATTLE OF LOVE stalked the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. PAULETTE CAVEAT off slowly, chased the pacesetter to midway of the far turn, then faded.
