MOP SQUEEZER set the pace along the inside, was headed at the sixteenth pole, then came again under pressure to edge MOON'S DUSTY STAR. The latter, stalked the pace, gained a slim lead at the sixteenth pole but couldn't hold off the winner in the final strides. SEJM'S LUNAR STAR saved ground, angled out after entering the stretch and outfinished the others. LADY BUCKINGHAM in good position, tired. TACTICAL MOVE failed to menace. EXTENDED APPLAUSE reserved after breaking poorly, advanced into contention four wide down the backstretch and into the far turn, then faltered. MAMA ELLA unhurried early, lacked the needed rally. SILVER INVITATION was not a factor.
