### Footnotes

PANAMA CITY vied for the lead off the rail, drifted out a bit entering the stretch, then drew clear under urging. CERRADOR vied for the lead three wide around the turn, then couldn't stay with the winner while drifting in through the stretch impeding DEFENSE MODE and proved best of the rest. COLONEL POTTER chased the pace into the stretch and gave way. DEFENSE MODE vied for the lead between horses into the stretch, then was steadied inside the eighth pole when CERRADOR crossed in front of him and tired. PRESENTLY failed to menace after bumping hard with LET IT BE HARDYBOY at the start. INDIAN FROM SKY was racing with the leaders when caught in tight on the backstretch, chased the pace along the inside around the turn and tired. HURRICANE AUSTIN was outrun after bumping with LET IT BE HARDYBOY at the start. LET IT BE HARDYBOY bumped soundly with PRESENTLY after being bumped by HURRICANE AUSTIN at the start, then was not a factor. Following a stewards inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of DEFENSE MODE, CERRADOR was disqualified and placed fourth for interference to that rival in the stretch.
