SWEET ENTICEMENT chased the pace, rallied to gain command at the quarter pole, then drew off while being kept to pressure. D'LUCCI GIRL tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. SHESMORETHANATIGER chased the pace three wide, made a run with SWEET ENTICEMENT to reach near even terms for command at the quarter pole, then tired in the drive. COVER UR HEART raced in contention three wide around the turn, then couldn't keep pace in the drive. STORM AND BEERS off slowly, was not a factor. SMOKEN ROSIE was outrun after breaking poorly. TRIP TO EDEN showed speed along the inside to the quarter pole, then faltered. SWEET SAINT GIRL was done early.
