**Footnotes**

CUMANA rated off the pace, steadied in the early going, rallied to reach LONGLASTINGLOVE at the eighth pole, then dueled with that rival to the wire and prevailed. LONGLASTINGLOVE stalked the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, responded when challenged by CUMANA at the eighth pole, then dueled with that rival and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. ADA CLARE reserved early, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid while up for the show. LA DOLFINA outran after being steadied from between rivals soon after the start, angled out for the drive and finished willingly. DAWN'S SONG allowed to settle after being steadied in the early going, advanced along the inside around the far turn to reach contention, then flattened out. MIDNIGHT SCRIMMAGE was saving ground when checked on the far turn and never threatened. POETIC PRINCESS outran rivals for the lead around the first turn, set the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. BRACKETOLOGY tracked the pace, checked to avoid running up on a rival on the far turn and failed to recover. BRIDGE TO GOLD was racing in striking position when checked in behind BRACKETOLOGY on the far turn and faltered. SWAP MANDATE chased the pace into the far turn, then faded.
