Footnotes

HARRY THE HAWK showed speed from the outside, eased to the inside on the turn after clearing DUTY BLUES, increased his advantage in midstretch, then was fully extended to hold sway. DUTY BLUES outrun for the lead, chased the winner off the hedge into the stretch but couldn't get to that rival while continuing on with good courage to hold the place. AZUL COAST reserved racing along the hedge, steadied in behind rivals in early stretch, angled out for racing room and rallied to just miss the place. TRAVERSE BAY chased the pace along the hedge into the stretch and weakened. BIG KAHUNA allowed to settle after bumping with NICKEL MILLIONAIRE at the start, raced three wide around the turn and gained some ground without threatening. OKEECHOBEE chased the leaders three wide around the turn and gave way. I'MANOTHERBROTHER was no factor after breaking poorly. NICKEL MILLIONAIRE bumped with BIG KAHUNA at the start, showed early foot and faded.
