MARIA'S IMAGE set the pace along the inside, responded when headed in the stretch and edged away under pressure. PAMPERED PRINCESS stalked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead in the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. DAKOTA LIGHT outrun early, advanced along the rail on the far turn to reach contention but couldn't sustain her bid. FIRM REALITY chased the pace, made a run to reach even terms for command entering the stretch, then gave way. REDOUBLED MISS failed to menace after stumbling at the start. EASY LASSIE chased the leaders into the far turn and tired. TEAK TOTEM raced four wide and faltered. GENTILE ALOUETTE was outrun. CHASE GAP raced three wide and faded.
